

Also Chametz that is unfit for human food and that tends to adhere to a surface of the inside of pans, pots or cooking utensils, and all kinds of live animals or birds that eat Chametz or mixture thereof. And to lease all places wherein the Chametz owned by me may be stored or found, especially in the premises specified below, and elsewhere, up to and including Friday 14 Nissan 5778/30th March 2018, at 10:22 a.m. Rabbi H Vogel has the full right to sell and to lease by transactions as he deems fit and proper and for such time he believes necessary, in accordance with all the detailed terms and forms, as explained in the general Contract of Sale, which will be signed on the instruction of Rabbi H Vogel. This authorisation is made part of that contract. Also, I do hereby give the said Rabbi H Vogel full power and authority to appoint a proxy in his place, with the full power to sell and to lease as provided herein. The above given power is in conformity with all the Torah, Rabbinical regulations and laws, and also in accordance with the laws of the Country. And to this I hereby affix my signature.
