TU B'SHEVAT—NEW YEAR FOR TREES

This day that marks the beginning of a “new year” for trees. This is the season in which the earliest-blooming trees in Israel begin a new fruit-bearing cycle.

Legally, the “new year” for trees relates to the various tithes that are separated from produce grown in Israel. These tithes differ from year to year in the seven-year shemittah cycle; the point at which a budding fruit is considered to belong to the next year of the cycle is the 15th of Shevat.

Tu B'Shevat is traditionally marked by eating fruit, particularly from the kinds that are singled out by the Torah such as grapes, figs, pomegranates, olives and dates.

In recognition of the new year for trees, there will be a fruit kiddush on Shabbat 18 January 2014.
