The next AJR talk is on Tuesday 5th September at 2.00pm. There is a nominal charge of £1.50 to cover the cost of refreshments.


Dr Pam Fox will be speaking about "The History of the Jews of Golders Green". Dr Fox is an excellent speaker all members of the community are invited to attend.
