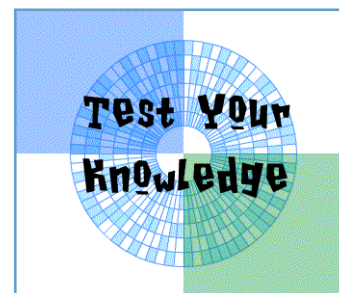

JEWISH TREASURES OF THE ASHMOLEAN



A book has just been published called "The Jewish Journey" by Rebecca Abrams, which features 22 objects from the Ashmolean Museum collection, spanning 4,000 years.

Rebecca Abrams is conducting a tour through the galleries to find out how Jewish life evolved from pre-Biblical times to the present day.

The tour is free and no booking is required. It takes place on Thursday 9 November from 2.30pm - 3.30pm, meeting at Gallery 21 at the Ashmolean Museum.

There are regular trains from Ealing Broadway station to Oxford station.

Oxford station is about a 10 minute walk from the Ashmolean Museum
